

Reflection & Readings

June 11 - A Reflection on The Solemnity Of The Most Holy Trinity

Patchwork Network Quilters Group

We ended another successful year on July 1st. Our very active members produced 440 quilts since last September and 70 tops are waiting to be finished. Most of these quilts go to a lot of different charities and some go to auctions and raffles for some much needed cash for these groups. Our own CWL got one of those quilts and raised over \$ 2.000.- for the Strathcona Food Bank with it.

We also give Canada-themed quilts to Quilts of Valor for war veterans, small quilts to Bags for Kids which go to children in Foster care, scraps of batting are used as stuffing for dog beds and go to veterinarians and the Edmonton Institution for Women has asked us again for a delegation to teach the inmates how to quilt.

Unfortunately we cannot encourage you to join us since we still have 21 people on a waiting list. The membership is capped at 110.
