Leader: Lord Jesus, we thank you for your Word. You invite us to be your brothers and sisters. (Mk. 3:34)

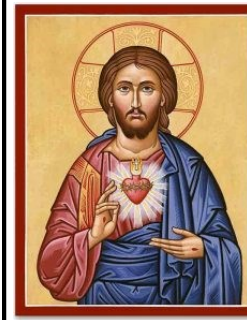
All: Lord Jesus, we thank you for love. Help us to show that love to those we meet each day.

Stewardship Reflections: June 10, 2018 — Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
GN 3: 9-15; PS 130: 1-8; 2 COR: 4:13-5:1; MK 3: 20-35
