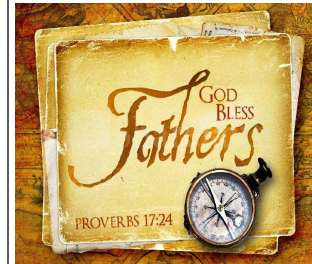

This year we even had a workshop on how to maintain and troubleshoot our sewing machines. At one of the meetings we learned how to do Sashico, which is an embroidery technique that started in Japan in the 16th century. We are very fortunate to have so many talented members who are able to teach us these new and exciting applications. Many thanks to all of them.

Clothing Nook- Information regarding our accomplishments this past year

The Volunteers of the Clothing Nook would like to say a big THANK YOU to all the parishioners who supported us this past year. Because of your generosity, we were able to accomplish the following:

We registered 65 shoppers. We had 17 shopping days on which we had a total of 301 adult shoppers, and as we allow 2 bags occasionally, approximately 350 bags were distributed to our County shoppers.

Again this year several parishioners fulfilled their call to "Stewardship of time" by delivering the following bags of clothing for us: (results are based on regular sized green garbage bags).

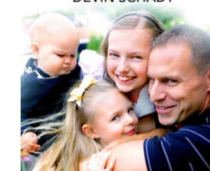
