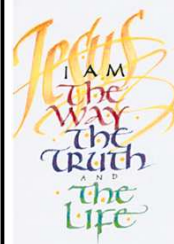
**Music Ministry

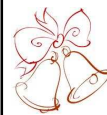

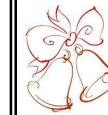

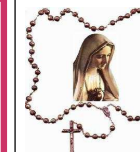


Happy Mother's Day

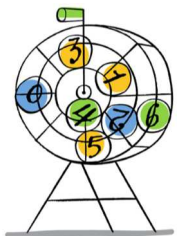
OLPH Parish Potluck on Friday May 19th

There is still time to select your favorite international dish. Please mark the date on your calendar and plan to join us!

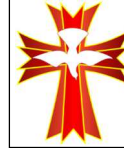

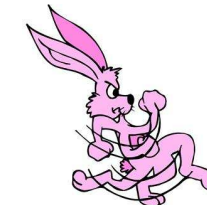
