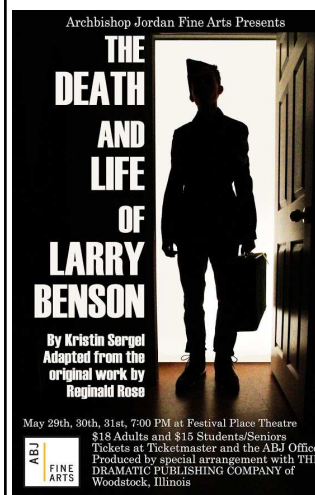
Part Time Weekend/ Evening Positions

The Carmelite Nuns Celebrating 25 Years

The Carmelite Nuns of Devon will be celebrating the 25th Anniversary of the dedication of their Monastery on May 30th with a Mass at 7 p.m.

On March 8th 1991 a group of cloistered nuns from Macau immigrated to Canada and began to search for a location for their new monastery. In 1992 they began construction in Parkland County and in March 1993 the monastery was completed.

The nuns live a simple family life. Prayer, liturgical and personal, alternate with spiritual reading, work and times of recreation together. Their withdrawal from the world is not an escape but is seen as a way to pray more effectively for its' needs.

Some of the larger parishes in the Archdiocese, of which ours is one, offer their crafts for sale once or twice a year since being an enclosed order the nuns do not have access to the public. They are most grateful for our support..
