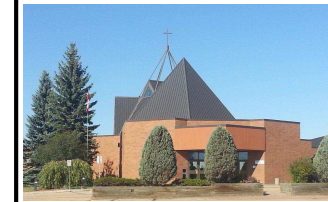

It is customary to make your First Reconciliation and First Communion in Grade two or older.

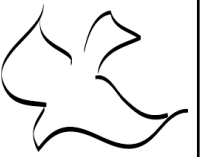

## Reflections & Readings

### October 22 - The Twenty-Ninth Sunday In Ordinary Time

Jesus is aware of the Pharisees' malice toward him in this Gospel passage. Jesus' one-line answer to them: "Give to the emperor the things that are the emperor's; and to God the things that are God's." Always Scripture is speaking directly to each of us. Let's ask ourselves: How often are we mean, or full of malice toward other people? How often do we muster up hatred toward another based on our own religious viewpoint? Jesus reminds us here that the God of Love cannot be served by hating anyone else. Venom belongs to the serpent, not to the children of God.
