Society of Saint Vincent de Paul
Focus on Ministry Weekend

This weekend the **OLPH Society of St Vincent de Paul** would like to share with you a little of our story.

WHO WE ARE: OLPH SSVP began in 2003 as members of an International Christian Community founded in Paris in 1833. Our purpose is to follow Christ through service to those in need and so bear witness to His compassionate and liberating love. This commitment is shown through person-to-person contact and served in a spirit of love, humility, respect, justice, joy and discretion.

WHAT WE DO: From 2003, we have served the needy/poor in Strathcona County as well as the women and children at Safe Place (Sherwood Park). Later on we extended our scope to helping the Edmonton SSVP as well as some other groups that serve the poor there. About 4 years ago we became part of the North of 60 Project set up by our SSVP National Office. This project serves Northern Canadian communities and at the present time we are assisting the people of Paulatuk (NWT). This summer we also donated over 300 bags of clothing and some tools to the Park Pentecostal Church for their outreach in Africa.

HOW WE DO IT: Our members are involved in one or any number of areas of service with time commitments that are flexible and vary according to the area of service and need. Areas of involvement include: **Home visitations, Phone Line (Help & Donations), Pickup/Delivery of Items, Sorting Donations, Poor Box and ...** SSVP is a registered charity fully run by volunteers receiving no monetary compensation for what we do. We rely on donations of time, goods and money to fulfill our mission and are authorized to issue official tax receipts for gifts in cash or by cheque. We belong to a very generous, caring Parish that is always helping us out and for this we are very grateful.

WHAT YOU CAN DO: YOU can make a difference in someone's life by living our mission in some way. We have many jobs needing to be done and are always looking for caring, fun loving and reliable workers interested in helping less fortunate people to meet their basic needs.
