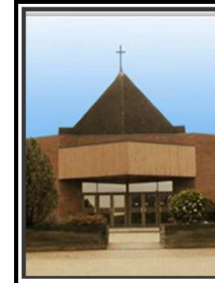

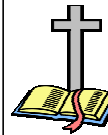


First Friday - All Day Adoration & Exposition/Benediction at 6:15 pm Mass

It is customary to make your First Reconciliation and First Communion in Grade two or older.

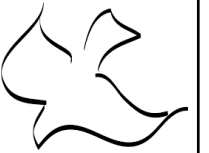
