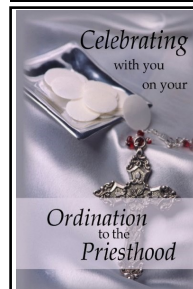
June 28, 2020 Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

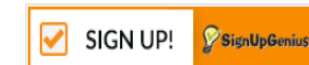
