





SignUpGenius My friends, I write this on Sunday morning at the end of June after perusing the number of folks signed up to serve at our Sunday Masses. Many Masses, too few commitments. Having said this, I am truly grateful to so many of you who selflessly sign up to serve

on a daily and a weekly basis. You are the ones that make our celebrations reverent and somewhat joyful because they are well organized, and we are able to focus on that which is truly important. "It is the Lord." Thank you, Thank you, Thank you.

My reason for making note of this at this time, is the following: Summer is here, thank you dear Jesus, and there may be an implied sense that we are slowing down the operation of our parish for the summer. Please be assured that our hours will remain the same, 7:30 am to 7:30 pm seven days a week. We will continue with two daily Masses 8:30 am and 6:15 pm, along with our regular Sunday Mass schedule. **How is that we can all do our part in responding to our baptismal call to assist in the celebrations of our Liturgies, weekday, and weekend?**

As you are aware, we require that for you to assist with the Holy Mass, you must sign up in advance, even if it is only thirty minutes before Mass. My philosophy in adopting the sign-up mechanism is to assist you in being intentional when you plan to attend a weekday or Sunday celebration. We plan when we will take vacations, when we will go shopping, when the kids have their sports, dance, or music. My prayer is that over time we will become more intentional about when we attend the Holy Mass. As we become more intentional, we will become more engaged. When we become more engaged, our inclination is to participate more fully in the celebration of the Mass. Certainly there are times when we just want to go to Mass and be part of the community. However, this is a large operation and there are many moving parts. My friends, I/we need you to step up and volunteer in an area that is of interest to you. We will provide the training needed; you just need to let us know who you are. The key to this is we need you, and you need to say yes.

Signing up and being intentional about which Mass we are attending and how we are participating provides integrity and purpose to this very important part of our lives. A reminder, when we engage in the Holy Mass we are engaging at a deeper level in the most important relationship in our lives: That of the person of our Lord Jesus Christ. We can talk to Jesus all day long and that is a good thing. But when you come to the Lord's own house you are stepping up your game and saying, this is indeed important to me.

My friends, summer is here, and my prayer is that you will all get away for a break

that suits your needs. We here at OLPH will do the same but our need for your presence and assistance will not diminish. Please pray and discern about this ask. **The most important ask I will ever make of you, is for your intentional engagement in, and commitment to, the life of our parish community.** Your full, active, conscious participation in our parish Liturgies will bear fruit that you never would have imagined my friends. You have my word on this.

As I celebrated nineteen years of priesthood this past week, one thing continues to be increasingly evident to me. The more effort and time that I put into my ministry in God's Church, the more rewarding and joyful my life becomes. My friends, I offer you this because I truly do want you to have what I have been blessed with in my life. Many of you already understand clearly what I am saying. I am speaking to those of you who in your heart know it is time to make the step from attendee to full active conscious participation. Once you experience the fruit of this journey, you will never turn back. It is indeed a joyful journey. God's blessings my friends.
