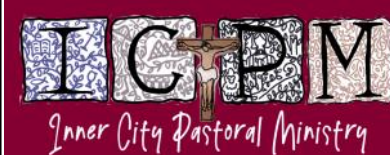

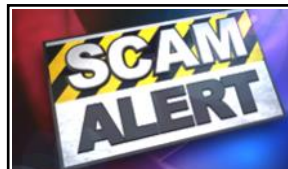

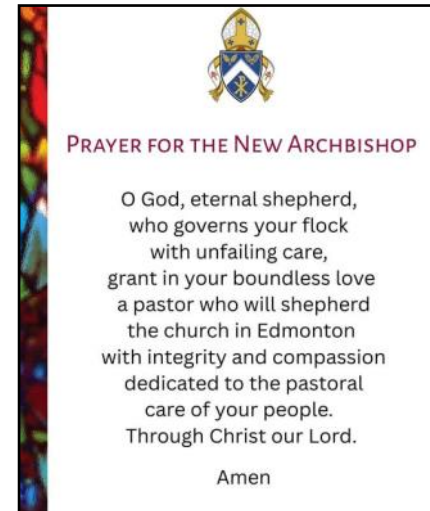
Part time job opening: Evening/Weekend Office Admin Staff


