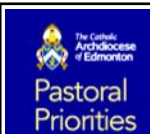

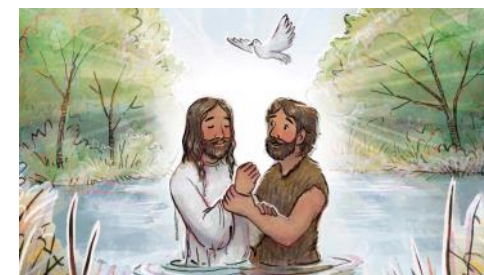
**FAMILY BAPTISM PREPARATION CLASS**

# REMINDERS for VOLUNTEERS



The Archdiocese of Edmonton has revised the Safe Environments program and retired the "Called to Protect" training course. Going forward, all Safe Environments training will now be delivered ONLINE through Praesidium Academy. *How does that impact new and existing volunteers/staff in our parish?*

Each current, registered OLPH parish volunteer has already been set up with a profile on Praesidium Academy. If you don't remember your password, please click the "Forgot Password" link on the login page and change your password. **Once you have logged in, please complete the following courses as soon as possible:**

- Keeping your Church Safe
- Preventing Abuse & Exploitation in Pastoral Ministry
- Duty to Report
- Every 2 years, a volunteer must login in to complete an Abuse Prevention Refresher course

**Volunteers in MEDIUM TO HIGH RISK positions (positions serving children and youth) must also complete:**

- Foundations: Preventing Abuse in Youth-Serving Organizations
- Positions serving elder and disabled persons
- Preventing Elder Abuse & Neglect
- Preventing Abuse Against Disabilities

**Volunteers in HIGH-RISK positions, including all Volunteer Coordinators must also complete:**

- Safety Equation
- Social Media
- Preventing Sexual Activity between Young Children
- Preventing Sexual Activity Between Adolescents
