





**Away from the Parish from January 5 through to February 1, 2026*

Now that we have our new roof and new sanctuary floor, we are ready to begin RENOVATIONS to the rest of our Nave!

The work will be starting the first week of January, through to the end of March.

The scope of these improvements include:

- Repairing the drywall ceilings on the east and west sides of the church
- Painting the ceilings and walls
- Installing new rubber floors in the aisles
- Installing carpet tiles under the pew areas, in the transepts and elevated platform

During this work, weekday Masses (8:30 am and 6:15 pm) will be held down in the Parish Hall. Saturday 5:00 pm and all Sunday Masses will remain up in the Sanctuary.

What Should Parishioners Expect?

- See the display in the foyer with the new materials and colors.
- Temporary plastic walls will isolate the work area from the rest of the church.
- Space will be a little tighter than normal – About one third of the pews will be out of service from January through March.
- The church will be at full capacity before Holy Week!

How can you help?

- Please pray for us – we are doing our best to restore the church to a worship space worthy of our Lord.
- Please be patient – renovations can be challenging.
- Please contact the parish office if you can volunteer to move pews or help with general clean up.
