



**Now that we have our new roof and new sanctuary floor, we are ready to begin RENOVATIONS to the rest of our Nave!**

The work will be starting the first week of January, through to the end of March.

**The scope of these improvements include:**

- Repairing the drywall ceilings on the east and west sides of the church
- Painting the ceilings and walls
- Installing new rubber floors in the aisles
- Installing carpet tiles under the pew areas, in the transepts and elevated platform



**What Should Parishioners Expect?**

- See the display in the foyer with the new materials and colors.
- Temporary plastic walls will isolate the work area from the rest of the church.
- Space will be a little tighter than normal – About one third of the pews will be out of service from January through March.
- The church will be at full capacity before Holy Week!
