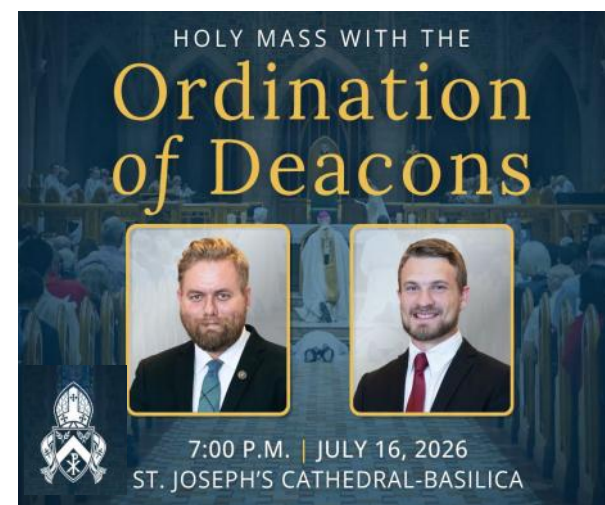

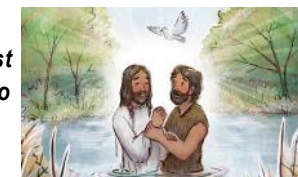
BAPTISM opens the door to the rest of our Catholic Sacraments. *If your child attends Catholic school but is not yet baptized, we have special support for your family!*

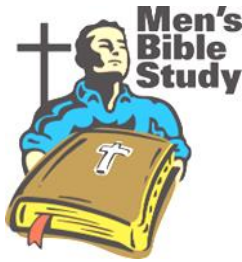

Change ~ The inevitable of life

Wednesday, July 15, is when the clergy movements within the Archdiocese will take place, and once again OLPH does not escape the action. As you are all aware, our dear Fr. Michael Arockiasamy Pancras SDB will be departing Our Lady of Perpetual Help after a short (four months), but meaningful time with us. Fr. Michael will take on the role of pastor at St. Dominic Savio parish in North Edmonton. Fr. Michael will do well at Savio, and though we are sorry to see him leave us so soon, it is important that we keep the big picture of the needs of the Church of the Archdiocese of Edmonton in focus when we hear about comings and goings that do not make a lot of sense at the local level.

Fr. Michael, we are grateful for your short, but stellar, service at OLPH and St. Francis, Tofield. We do know that you will love the people of St. Dominic Savio, and that they in turn will love you.

Filling the void created by Fr. Michael's departure we have welcomed Fr. Arun Malayappan Jayamary SDB to our OLPH family. Fr. Arun is a gifted young priest who has good energy and is zealous in his service and learning about the Church in Western Canada. Fr. Arun has already come to a comfort level with Masses in the parish and in our assisted living/care centers. I am excited for the school year to begin, as I believe that Fr. Arun will be a natural fit in the classrooms of Elk Island Catholic Schools. Typically, Salesian priests are well trained and educated in specific areas, with the goal of serving their charism of vocational training for young people. Fr. Arun is trained in the electronics sector and yes, he is well trained theologically. Good things will come with this young priest. Fr. Arun has just succeeded in passing his driver's knowledge test. We hope he is less than a month or so away in passing his road test. Until then, we are still looking for volunteers to get Fr. Arun to the parish, to Tofield, and back to the Salesian house at the end of the day. If you can assist us, please call the parish office. It is a good way to get to know your parish priest. The Salesians live fifteen minutes from the parish, with most of the travel on the Henday and the Yellowhead.

My friends, we are truly excited to celebrate the ordination to the transitional Diaconate of Andrew Sheedy of our parish community, and Daniel Sale, this Thursday evening, July 16, at 7:00 pm at St. Josephs Basilica. We have a bus leaving the parish at 6:00 pm sharp if you would like to attend what will be a very special event for these young men and for the Archdiocese of Edmonton. As you may know, Deacon-elect Andrew and his family are based in St. Albert, and Deacon-elect Daniel hails from North Edmonton. We are experiencing a wonderful period in the life of the Archdiocese of Edmonton. We have these two men, whom we pray will be ordained to the ministerial priesthood sometime in the next year. We have several other young men who are close to finishing their seminary formation within the next couple of years. This, of course, is great news for the Church of Edmonton. There is some very good work being done

in vocations.

As you may remember, Deacon-elect Andrew and our parish are the primary testing ground for the implementation of the new formation requirements for young men who are discerning the priesthood. Previously, one would be ordained a Deacon and spend his last year in the seminary formation as a Deacon. He would be ordained a priest in June or thereabouts, and then in July would be assigned to a parish as an associate pastor.

The new mandate has the seminarian completing his theological studies, with an assignment as a seminarian to a parish upon completion of studies. The idea is that the parish community will be able to walk with the individual as a seminarian. In a short period of time, the seminarian would be ordained a transitional deacon, as the community continues to walk with and support him on his journey. Finally, he would be ordained to the ministerial priesthood; again, with his parish community walking with him.

The brilliance of this methodology, in my view, is that the seminarian can become comfortable in the community which he is living and serving. He comes to know the faithful of the parish community, and they come to know him. The journey to the priesthood can provide a significant degree of stress for a young man discerning the biggest step of his life. I believe completing the final leg of the journey among families whom you know, will reduce that stress. Parishioners who love and support you! This, in my view, creates a beautiful, caring ambience, within which a young man feels supported and loved, as he fully embraces his call to the ministerial priesthood.

Thank you, and best wishes Fr. Michael. Welcome Fr. Arun. God's continued blessings, Deacon-elect Andrew Sheedy.
